ATTACHING A MSR/CARD SWIPE

1. Power off the CS200.
2. With the screen facing you, place the MSR at a 45 degree angle from the right side of the screen.
3. Carefully pull the MSR toward the screen until the MSR snaps into the connection.
NOTE: DO NOT FORCE IT OR SCREW IT DOWN TO MAKE THE CONNECTION. THIS WILL DAMAGE THE MSR BOARD!
4. Attach the 3 screws that hold the MSR to the machine.
5. Power up the machine.
6. When fully booted, open Notepad and swipe a credit card to test the MSR. **NOTE: NO CHARGES WILL BE APPLIED TO THE CARD!**
7. The MSR may need to be configured. To do this, you will need to contact the vendor for the proper configuration settings.
8. If changes need to be made to the MSR's configuration, use the Magswipe Configuration Utility, which is installed on the system. It can be found in the **START – All PROGRAMS – MAGSWIPE CONFIGURATION UTILITY** menu.
